I often think of her and how giving she was; how people who did not have food or other necessities would have something thanks to my grandmother.

Her generosity and the care and support of Rescue Mission friends like you remind me of the call to action in Hebrews 13:16, "Do not neglect to do good and to share what you have, for such sacrifices are pleasing to God." I've kept that with me. How can I do good, and share what I have with others?

Beyond meeting the basic needs of those who are seeking refuge at the Rescue Mission, I am personally honored and called to share God's love and wisdom to those who are alone and in need of counsel. God's love is

represented in kind words and small gestures, as a listening ear, or in prayer. Love in action.
