STEP 1: CHOOSE THE VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY THAT FITS YOU

We offer a variety of volunteer experiences for individuals, small groups, and larger organizations.

INDIVIDUAL & SMALL GROUP OPPORTUNITIES

WAREHOUSE SUPPORT

Help process donated goods that support Rescue Mission programs and thrift store operations.

FOOD SERVICE SUPPORT

Three meals are served daily on our main campus located on Gifford Street in downtown Syracuse.

THRIFTY SHOPPER & 3FIFTEEN SUPPORT

Our network of thrift stores helps fund Rescue Mission programs while providing affordable goods to the community.

LARGE GROUP AND PLANNED OPPORTUNITIES

FOLD FOR HOPE

This opportunity supports groups of approximately 5–10 volunteers at the Warehouse located in Liverpool. Participants help fold clothing and package items that will be distributed through Rescue Mission programs and stores.

POLKA TOT SORT

This opportunity takes place on our main campus and includes a guided tour of the facility and can accommodate large groups of 20+. Groups help sort and untag donated items to prepare them for processing at our Warehouse for resale.
